A very simple very short no-stress Christmas story for this busy time of year! This story could be repeated many times in the run up to Christmas with variations each time if wished.

In a snowy, snowy land there's a snowy snowy wood

In the snowy snowy wood there's a snowy snowy house

In the snowy snowy house there's a beautiful big Christmas tree

Under the beautiful big Christmas tree there's a box...

Take out the box, open it up...

The X in the box, the box under the tree, the tree in the house, the house in the wood, and the wood in the snowy snowy land.

Notes

You can make hand shapes or signs to indicate the land, trees, house, Christmas tree and box. Or you could make confetti out of white tissue paper and let this fall on the children as you tell the first part of the story. An ice pack for 'coldness' might be nice to use as well. You could use a branch from a real Christmas tree or simply a string of fairy lights or some tinsel to indicate the tree.

If you are telling the story to a group it might be a good idea to have multiple copies of these props. Some of the other staff-members present could help you with the prophandling.

If you are using a real box you could have a different object inside each time you tell the story. Or you could use the story as a sort of advent calendar with a wee present for a different child in the box every time.
